At present, I am working primarily online, with flexible hours on weekday afternoons and evenings, and on Saturdays until 3 pm. Online mediation is accessible to anyone with privacy and a good internet connection. While I always recommend that my mediation clients consult with separate mediation-friendly attorneys before signing their settlement agreements, some clients do consult with attorneys, and some choose not to. For clients who wish to represent themselves, I offer referrals to Legal Document Assistants (LDAs) statewide, for help with their court documents for their self-representation.
